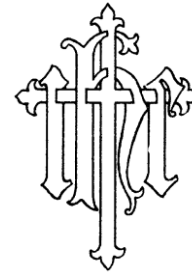
Our neighbors, the **Prevention of Blindness Society** of Metropolitan Washington are be holding a free community vision screening and open house on 9/16, 9/17, and 9/18, at their headquarters, located at 233 Massachusetts Ave NE. Children will be screened for vision problems (on 9/16). Volunteer ophthalmologists will be on-site to provide prescriptions. Free free prescription eyeglasses will be provided to children (ages 3-18). Adults will be screened for glaucoma (9/16-9/18). The District has among the highest incidence of glaucoma nationwide. Those at higher risk include people ages 40 and up with medical conditions such as diabetes, African Americans, and Hispanics. Volunteer ophthalmologists will be on-site to answer questions.
